- **OFFICER'S TRAINING SCHOOL (OTS):** Designed to inform the student of the basis of the real world of STARFLEET. Prepares student to become a commissioned officer. Required for all commanders and first officers of chapters and shuttles.
- **OFFICER'S COMMAND COLLEGE (OCC):** Required for all ship Captains and first officers. OTS is a prerequisite. Course uses specifically designed manual as well as handbook and is designed to give insight into effective leadership.
- **FLAG OFFICER'S SCHOOL (FOS):** OTS and OCC are prerequisites. Three course levels: STARFLEET Configuration, STARFLEET Leadership and STARFLEET Command. Manual covers all three courses.
- **COLLEGE OF COMMUNICATIONS (COC):** College of Communications students will learn the fundamentals of creating newsletters, flyers, bookmarks, etc. that will help them present a professional and fun image of their chapters. Computers may be used but are not necessary to pass Main Course. At this time, the Newsletter course and Interspecies Communications are ready for students. The Basic Web Design is being updated and will be available as soon as possible.
- **COLLEGE OF FEDERATION STUDIES (COFS):** There are 20 tests currently available: 6 Tests in the area of The History of the Enterprise, 6 tests in Federation Law and 8 Tests in Special Federation Studies
- **COLLEGE OF HISTORY (COH):** College offers 3 levels of study, Bachelor's Degree, Master's Degree, and Doctorate Degree in subjects of real Earth history and some Star Trek Universe history.
- **SCHOOL OF LANGUAGE STUDIES (SOLS):** Ten degree levels: Bachelor's, Master's, Doctorate, Post-Doctorate, and six levels of Advanced Studies. Courses convey real world concepts through Trek examples drawn from series and films (no novels). Star Trek Encyclopedia suggested reference.
- **SCHOOL OF LITERATURE (SOL):** The purpose of this course is to familiarize students with common literary devices and terminology. Students who complete this course should be able to recognize devices used by authors in books, television episodes and movies. This course can be taken electronically for free. To do this, please send me the information required on the standard academy application, your e-mail address, and whether you prefer a WORD 97 file or a plain text file.
- **COLLEGE OF ALIEN HISTORY AND CULTURE (CAHC):** Currently 10 courses available designed to provide the membership with a fun way to learn about different Trek cultures. Consists of Federation, Romulan, Klingon, Vulcan, Trill, Borg, Ferengi, Bajoran, Cardassian, and Misc Worlds courses. Recommend Star Trek Encyclopedia and Star Trek Chronology for reference. Courses are also available online.
- **SCHOOL OF MUSIC (SOM):** Music, instruments and vocalizations used in Star Trek episodes and movies. Two levels of courses.
- **SCHOOL OF TREK HUMOR (SOTH):** This School invites the student to explore the comic elements of selected incidents in the series and films. Obviously, this course is designed for fun, but is also intended as an invitation to think about what it is that makes something amusing.
- **SCHOOL OF TREK ROMANCE (SOTR):** Three levels, all TOS. (Later tests will deal with other Trek series.)
- **SCHOOL OF UNUSUAL KNOWLEDGE (SOUK):** This School is comprised of an exam which touches on all sorts of unusual knowledge including country names which have changes with the times:, plurals of words, and names of Male-Female-Offspring. This along with other examples will really test your knowledge of the unusual.
- **CULINARY SCHOOL (BURPS):** Biil's Unique Recipe Preparatory School (B.U.R.P.S.) covers a little bit of everything from soup to nuts. The normal and the exotic, with over 300 questions, including Star Trek related questions in quite a few courses. The material is broken down into several small tests.
- **VULCAN ACADEMY OF SCIENCE (VAS):** 15 major sciences and 36 sub-sciences, plus Logic and Trivia. The trivia is taken from the original series and the first 5 movies. Send a LSASE with the application for a curriculum guide and further instructions.

- **COLLEGE OF COMPUTER HISTORY (COCH):** Three course levels available, Bachelor (History of Computers), Master's (Modern Computers) and Doctoral (Artificial Life Vs. Organic Intelligence).
- **COLLEGE OF MEDICINE (SACOM):** An introduction to the basic aspects of Medicine. Course includes Counseling, Pharmacology and Nursing. 5 basic courses and 13 advanced courses. Access to World Book Encyclopedia suggested.
- **SCHOOL OF ENGINEERING (SOE):** Four courses available, Basic Engineering (must be taken first), Advanced Engineering, Basic Support Services Technology and Advanced Support Services Technology.
- **COLLEGE OF TRADE AND COMMERCE (COTAC):** The College of Trade and Commerce is designed to facilitate a better understanding of the various ways Trade and Commerce affect the world of Trek, individual chapters, and even real life. The COTAC Shuttle Treasury Course is designed to teach the new shuttle how to determine how to choose a bank, account for funds, maintain a ledger, etc. Future courses will include an Advanced COTAC trivia, and a masters of COTAC Course. Honor grads will be recognized.
- **SCHOOL OF CULTURAL ANTHROPOLOGY (SOCA):** This College consists of three course levels: Bachelor's , Master's, and Doctoral. It explores the customs and rituals of various Trek cultures.
- **SCHOOL OF TREKNOLOGY (SOT):** This school was design to increase your knowledge of Trek and to build your research skills. This School has five sections. Four of the sections deal with the Star Trek series themselves. The fifth section deals with the movies. We can provide tests for those who are visually impaired. We can provide test in print, in large type, and in Braille.
- **SHIP'S COUNSELORS COLLEGE (SCC):** This College consists of six courses: Listening, Jealousy, Stress, Anger, Grief, and Diplomacy. More may be added at a later date.
- **ACROCADEMY (ACRO):** Closed for Reconstruction
- **SECURITY SCHOOL (SASS):** Courses currently available: Basic Security, Intermediate School, Convention Security Officer's Course, and Early Law Enforcement History Course.
- **RADIO SCHOOL (SORS):** Closed for Reconstruction
- **COLLEGE OF SURVIVAL STUDIES (COSS):** The College of Survival Studies contains three schools. Basic Survival School introduces the requirements for human survival in hostile environments on Earth, on Luna, and in space. Mapping Survival School teaches elementary 2-D and 3-D mapping and navigation. Survival Strategies School analyses the use of emergency procedures by the different Star Trek crews. Some classes may be conducted on-line. Students outside the USA do not need to send postage. Write or e-mail for a catalogue.
- **SCHOOL OF STRATEGY AND TACTICS (SOST):** 4 Courses. Covers basic strategy and tactics with review of historical figures, battles and events and applies usage in the Star Trek Universe in both Ship to Ship and Fleet actions.
- **COLLEGE OF STARSHIP OPERATIONS (COSO):** College is the final replacement of the Post Graduate School. The college offers four courses; Starship Operations I, II, III, and Guidance And Navigation Technology. Courses free to all Directors and Assistant Directors of SFA.
- **KLINGON WARRIOR ACADEMY (KWA):** Divided into three separate areas: the Warrior Apprentice; the Warrior Journeyman; and the Warrior Craftsman. All graduates who score a 100% on all their tests will take a special graduate course. These special graduates who pass will join the Klingon Warriors Hall of Fame, where they can choose a Klingon name which will be placed in the Hall of Honor and will receive the Sword of Honor pin and a special certificate. The questions are from a variety of Trek sources, including the Trek television series, movies, encyclopedias, as well as other canon and non-canon resources.
- **VESSEL READINESS CERTIFICATION PROGRAM (VRCP):** The Vessel Readiness Certification Program gathers all the diplomas on a ship and sorts them into departments. Each Department receives a Readiness Certification. When all departments on a Vessel are certified, the Vessel receives a Vessel Readiness Certificate, which means that it is deemed spaceworthy.
